Re: ITAS – (Indigenous Tutorial Assistance Scheme)

The University receives a grant from DEST to provide additional tutoring to Indigenous students according to strict guidelines. These funds are administered by Kumbari/Ngurpai Lag under the direction of John Williams-Mosley.

As part of the ITAS process, what DEST calls an “Educational Assessment” is required from the Course Lecturer or Course Tutor regarding the need of the student.

The Educational Assessment need not be a long statement, but it does, for instance, need to make a point that the course is reasonably challenging for a student with the academic background of the person being considered.

Guidance is also sought as to particular areas of common weakness where the student may need help, eg., with the underlying maths, or essay writing, research skills, etc.

The ITAS tutor will base their Work Program on the Educational Assessment
