The majority of these memorabilia have been donated by former UniSQ employees or students.





Wooden UniSQ Plaque carved by McGregor Summer School student, John Van Zeeland (1991).




Framed Bark Collage of the UniSQ Phoenix rising from the ashes. Created by Juanita Toombs (2007), a former UniSQ employee.

Wilkinson commemorative sword donated by a former UniSQ Council member (1981); HMV portable gramophone and records (circa 1933).




