

Terms and Conditions of the 2020 "USQ's Online Career Fair Drone" Competition

1. The 2020 Online Career Fair Drone ('Competition') is conducted by the University of Southern Queensland ('USQ'), Toowoomba, Queensland, 4350, ABN: 40234 732 081
2. Information on how to enter forms part of these Terms and Conditions. Participating in the Competition is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
3. The Competition commences on the 9 March 2020 at 8:00 a.m. (AEST) and concludes on the 13 March 2020 at 5:00 p.m. (AEST) ('Competition Period').
4. Entry is free and limited to graduates of the USQ and current students studying with the USQ and who reside in Australia (Entrants'). Entry to the Competition is available only to current students and USQ graduates who select the checkbox to enter the Competition when registering or logging into the VFair portal during the Competition Period, and who find the picture of drone hidden within pages of the Career Fair (VFair) platform, and who click on this picture and submit the entry form (the 'Entry'). There is a limit of 1 entry per day, per person.
5. There are 3 Prizes for the Competition (Total Prize Pool Value \$640), each Prize will be a DJI Tello Drone, valued at AUD \$128. The Prize shall not be redeemable or transferable for cash. USQ reserves the right to substitute the Prize for another prize of equal value or greater in value in the event the Prize is not able to be awarded. Any change in the value of a Prize between the commencement and conclusion of the Competition is not the responsibility of USQ. In addition, any terms and conditions (including any time limitations) applicable to the Prize and ancillary costs incurred in taking and using the Prize is the responsibility of the Winner and note USQ.
6. An Entrant in the Competition may win only one Prize. 3 winning Entries will be selected by USQ in a random draw on 25th March, 2020 at the University of Southern Queensland, Toowoomba Campus before 5:00 p.m. and the Potential Winners will be contacted directly via email. To successfully claim the Prize and be determined in USQ's discretion as Winner, a Potential Winner must within ten (10) business days of the conclusion of the Competition Period provide USQ with sufficient details to enable USQ to make contact, confirm their student status and mailing address to receive the Prize. In the event that all Prizes are not successfully claimed, USQ will conduct a redraw until such time as they are.
7. USQ will mail the Prizes within thirty (30) business days from the conclusion of the Competition Period.
8. An Entrant's personal information as defined by the Information Privacy Act 2009 (Qld) may be collected, used and disclosed by USQ for university and competition purposes and other incidental and associated functions and activities and in the case of the Winner, including disclosure in publications made available to the public throughout the world by use of on-line, print and other media services and communication tools and to third parties as required for redeeming any part of a Prize. By entering the Competition you consent to the above use and disclosure, including transfer outside of Australia. A request to access, update or correct any Personal Information held by USQ should be directed to the USQ Privacy Officer at privacy@usq.edu.au.
9. USQ does not accept any responsibility for late, lost, illegible, incomplete or misdirected, incorrectly submitted, delayed, or corrupted Entries, whether due to error, omission, alteration, tampering, deletion, theft, destructions, transmission, interruption, communications failure or otherwise. USQ reserves the right to disqualify any Entry in its discretion which is deemed by the University to be inappropriate, offensive, or discriminatory or in excess of one entry per day.

10. All decisions of USQ in relation to conduct of the Competition are binding and conclusive and no correspondence will be entered into.
11. USQ reserves the right in its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition including varying or extending the Competition Period or time of the draw. If for any reason this Competition is not capable of running as planned because of infection of tampering, unauthorised intervention or any other causes beyond the control of USQ which may corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Competition or otherwise, USQ reserves the right in its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition subject to any applicable legislation. USQ also reserves the right to disqualify any individual who USQ has reason to believe has breached any of these conditions, or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the Competition.
12. Neither USQ nor any of its employees, contractors, agents and suppliers associated with the Competition will be liable for any claim, loss, damage, injury, cost and expense suffered, sustained or incurred (including but not limited to indirect or consequential) as a result of, arising out of, or in any way connected with the Competition of your Entry (or winning and use of the Prize if a Winner); except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law (in which case that liability is limited to the maximum allowable by law) and you agree to indemnify and release USQ and its employees from any loss or damage suffered from any breach of these Terms and Conditions, including breach of any warranty being false or incorrect. This clause survives the conclusion of the Competition.
