

## University of Southern Queensland – School of Creative Arts Future Visions Art Competition Terms and Conditions

1. The University of Southern Queensland – School of Creative Arts Future Visions Art Competition ('Competition') is conducted by the USQ School of Creative Arts, Toowoomba, Queensland, 4350, ABN: 40 234 732 081 (USQ).
2. The Competition entries open at 09:00 (AEST) on Thursday 18 February 2021 and close at 23:59 (AEST), on Wednesday 31 March 2021 ('the Competition Period'), judging will commence following entries closing.
3. Information on how to enter the Competition forms part of these Terms and Conditions. By entering the Competition you are deemed to have accepted these Terms and Conditions.
4. Entry into this competition is free and open to all mediums. You are eligible to enter this competition if you are a South East Queensland based Senior High School Student currently undertaking visual art study/ classes at your high school (year 11 and 12).
5. To enter entrants must complete either the online entry process by visiting [usq.edu.au/study/faculty-events/2021/01/Exhibitions/Competition-Future-Visions](http://usq.edu.au/study/faculty-events/2021/01/Exhibitions/Competition-Future-Visions), click 'enter now' follow the prompts to provide personal contact information and upload a maximum of three images of up to three works with a 25 word summary to accompany each work explaining the piece to the judges OR entrants can download a hardcopy, PDF version of the application form from the same website, complete and return via email to [jenkins@usq.edu.au](mailto:jenkins@usq.edu.au).
6. One entry per person, which can include up to three separate works. Images of your work are to be submitted in the first instance as per the process outlined above, finalists will be required to deliver their works to USQ Arts Gallery, A Block, 19 April 2021 for the exhibition and final judging round.
7. The total value of the Prize Pool for the Competition is AUD \$800 and comprises of three prizes i.e.
  - First Prize *The School of Creative Arts Art Prize*: \$500 (cash in the form of cheque or money order);
  - Second Prize: \$200 (cash in the form of cheque or money order);
  - Third Prize: \$100 (cash in the form of cheque or money order); and
  - Finalists: Certificate stating they are a finalist.
8. A panel selected by the University of Southern Queensland (USQ) will select finalists following entries closing on 31 March 2021. Finalists will be required to deliver their works to *A Block, USQ Toowoomba Campus, West St, Darling Heights, QLD 4350* between 19 April 2021. During the delivery period a group of USQ selected volunteers will unpack and hang works. Final judging to determine the remaining prizes will take place on 21 April 2021 in the USQ Art Gallery by a panel of USQ Visual Art representatives. The work that the panel feels most fits with the ethos of the Future Visions Competition (i.e. to

showcase the professional and emerging art practices in Qld high schools) will be deemed the winner, with second and third prizes judged similarly.

9. Finalists will be notified via email, phone or post by Thursday, 1 April 2021, winners will be announced on the website, via email, and by phone 22 April 2021. No open event will take place in 2021, however the exhibition will be open to the public during business hours from 22 April – Thursday 27 May.
10. Artworks will be on display are part of the exhibition for (22 April – 27 May) four weeks and can be collected between 28 – 31 May from *A Block, USQ Toowoomba Campus, West St, Darling Heights, QLD 4350*. This exhibition will be hosted in the UISQ Art Gallery in A Block as well as the School of Creative Arts Website.
11. Prizes are as listed above and are non-transferable. The USQ School of Creative Arts reserves the right to substitute a Prize for another Prize of equal value or greater value in the event a Prize is not able to be awarded. Any change in the value of the Prizes between the commencement and conclusion of the Competition is not the responsibility of the USQ School of Creative Arts.
12. In addition, any terms and conditions applicable to the Prizes and ancillary costs incurred in taking and using the Prize is the sole responsibility of the winner and not USQ School of Creative Arts. It is the sole responsibility of the winner to check the expiry date of the Prize and use the Prize within the time limit specified. USQ accepts no liability for content of the ticketed show or associated parties actions.
13. In the event a Prize is unclaimed, this prize will not be redrawn or reallocated by USQ.
14. All decisions of the USQ School of Creative Arts in relation to the conduct of the Competition are binding and conclusive and no correspondence will be entered into.
15. Your Personal Information as defined by the Information Privacy Act 2009 (Qld) may be collected, used and disclosed by The USQ School of Creative Arts for university and competition purposes and other incidental and associated functions and activities including use in any communications publications marketing or promotional activities associated with the Competition or other university purposes. By entering the Competition you consent to The USQ School of Creative Arts using and disclosing any part of your personal information as set out above including transferring your personal information outside of Australia. You may withdraw your consent to future use and disclosure of personal information in promotional and marketing activities and publications at any time by written notice to the The USQ School of Creative Arts Privacy Officer at [privacy@usq.edu.au](mailto:privacy@usq.edu.au), and upon receipt of such notice, The USQ School of Creative Arts will take reasonable steps to cease using and disclosing that personal information as soon as reasonably possible. In some instances, USQ will not be able to cease the use or disclosure, for example, where information has been cached by others. A request to access, update or correct any personal information held by USQ should be directed to the USQ Privacy Officer.
16. Copyright of your intellectual property remains with you, however the USQ School of Creative Arts reserves the right to use images of you or your work to

promote future Future Visions competitions. Please note your work won't be use to promote other events.

17. The USQ School of Creative Arts, its employees will not be liable for any claim, loss, damage, injury, cost and expense suffered, sustained or incurred (including but not limited to indirect or consequential) as a result of, arising out of, or in any way connected with the Competition or your entry (or winning and use of the Prize if a Prize winner) and you agree to indemnify and release The USQ School of Creative Arts or its employees from all such claims made or sustained as a result of entering this Competition.
18. The USQ School of Creative Arts reserves the right in its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition including extending closing time of the Competition or varying the time of a draw.
19. Neither The USQ School of Creative Arts nor any of its employees, contractors, agents, and suppliers associated with this Competition will be liable for any liability, loss, damage, or expense (including direct, indirect or consequential loss or loss of profits) suffered or incurred (whether or not arising from any person's negligence arising out of, or in connection of the Competition, including if you are a Winner, your use of the Prize; except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law (in which case that liability is limited to the maximum allowable by law)) and the Entrant indemnifies The USQ School of Creative Arts for any loss or damage suffered from any breach by you of these Terms and Conditions. This clause survives the conclusion of the Competition.

If for any reason this Competition is not capable of running as planned because of infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of The USQ School of Creative Arts which may corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Competition or otherwise, The USQ School of Creative Arts reserves the right in its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition subject to any written directions under applicable legislation. USQ also reserves the right to disqualify any individual who The USQ School of Creative Arts has reason to believe has breached any of these conditions, or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the Competition.
