Class **Acrylic Landscape to Figure**

We provide this list of materials as a guide only for you to bring to the School. Your Tutor has compiled this list so you can embrace the class and skills being taught. The University Bookshop will provide a discount of 10% on art supplies prior to and during the McGregor School.

Equipment and Materials

- 5 x 60x60cm canvases per student (available at the Art Shed @ \$40 per deep edged gallery standard canvas or \$17 per deep edged studio canvas).
- 1 x 250ml tub of the following colours. The Art Shed has 250ml tubs for approx. \$11 each. These colour in Atelier (a superior brand) are more expensive.
 - Brilliant red
 - Yellow deep
 - Orange
 - Lemon yellow
 - Olive green
 - Light green
 - Hookers deep green
 - Purple
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Monastral Cerulean
 - Pale Turquoise
 - Black
 - Titanium White (probably prefer Atelier as Montmartre white is too thin)

Brushes

Participants are encouraged to bring their own favourite brushes. However if you wish to buy new they are available for approximately:

- Daler Rowney Natural Selection Brush Pot (10 piece for \$26.30) or
- Daler Rowney Gold Taklon Synthetic Brush Pot (10 piece for \$26.30) or
- MontMarte Acrylic Brush Set in box 7 piece (\$29) or
- MontMarte Fat Liner Brush Set in Taklon and Squirrel hair 7 piece (\$25)

Notes

Participants can either bring their own materials from home/studio if they have them or if they want to buy them especially for this course, then total cost would be:

- . canvases -- between \$80-200 depending on which canvases from above list they choose.
- . paints -- \$121 if they choose 250ml Montmartre paint tubs

- brushes -- approx. \$30

For the life-modelling sketching classes, I will have a stock of paper/cardboard available for participants at approx. \$2 per sheet. I will provide crayon, charcoal and pencils for sketching classes.

On the last day, I propose that those participants who want to work on a larger canvas can purchase a Montmartre canvas from me at cost price (eg 60x90cm canvas would be approx. \$40).

Approximate cost of materials \$200 depending on what you already have in your artwares collection.

*Please note that these costs are **approximate**, and depend on factors such as quantity, quality etc*

N.B. It is advisable to mark your equipment for easy identification.

Bring a Coffee mug – regular black tea and coffee, full cream milk and sugar **are** supplied by the School. **should you require decaf, herbal teas, other milk types or artificial sweeteners please feel welcome to bring your own.*

IMPORTANT: All electrical equipment required for your class at USQ must be 'tag-tested' by a qualified electrician prior to arrival in order to comply with Queensland Workplace Health & Safety legislation. Items include: extension cords, all power tools etc.

HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES AND MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEETS.

If you bring any hazardous substance to the McGregor School, please ensure that you obtain a MSDS (Material Safety Data Sheet) from the supplier or obtain one from the manufacturer of this substance.

To do this, either ask the supplier from whom you purchase the hazardous substance or read the contact details on the hazardous substance and contact the manufacturer and ask for a MSDS. Once you have obtained the MSDS, bring it with you to the school, and hand in a copy to the McGregor School office, or the Tutor.

Hazardous substance can be: e.g. solvents, acids, some paint and glues, chemicals, fixatives, fluxes and solders.

If you are unsure, the Supplier and or manufacturer should be able to inform you if the substance is classed as hazardous.

STRICTLY NO FILMING OR PHOTOGRAPHY OF ARTWORKS AT WORKSHOP

Workshop runs 9.00am to 4.30pm. You must provide your own lunch Monday to Friday. Please note allergies will be catered for as best we can but depending on the level of dietary/allergy needed to be catered for this may incur a surcharge.

WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY – IMPORTANT!!

As the McGregor Schools are the responsibility of the University of Southern Queensland all provisions of the Workplace Health and Safety Act and Regulations must be followed.

The Compliance Code for the Management of Hazardous Substances requires that

- A Register of all Hazardous Substances to be brought onto the Campus or used at the Winter School is to be completed by each Tutor before the commencement of the School and supplied to the McGregor Schools Office.

- A copy of each MSDS must be provided in each room or area that the hazardous substance is to be used
- All students must be informed of the MSDS before the Hazardous substance is used and students must be instructed to read the MSDS

Please enclose Material Safety Data Sheets for any hazardous substances you will be supplying for the class - e.g. dyes, paints, chemicals, etc
