Permanent White  
Ultramarine Blue  
Olive Green  
Flame Red  
Lemon Yellow  
Raw Umber  
Burnt Sienna

#### *Optional*

Phthalo Blue  
Permanent Yellow Deep

NOTE: Don't leave material buying to the last minute as supplies at the moment are a bit patchy. All the materials can be bought at Ekersley's.

Tutor will bring extra paint brushes for use and a few extra paint colours

**Approximate material cost** - \$115 is the estimated material cost. Please note you may already have some items in your art wares collection. Sometimes a tutor or the McGregor Retreats may be able to buy items in bulk to get the best price and we would then seek reimbursement from you. This will be communicated if required.

***Daily Schedule:***

DAY ONE

- Composition of painting
- Composing of small painting using images the student has bought to class
- Use of gouache – how it applies, issues to avoid when applying it
- Draw up small painting
- Start a small single/ practice painting

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DAY TWO

- Work on painting and finish practice painting
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DAY THREE

- Composition of larger progressive painting
- Composing (drawing up) of elements that compliment each other using the images the student has bought to class or the tutor supplied
- Talk through any issues problems that arose in the smaller painting to help when working on the larger one.

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DAY FOUR

- Start Progressive painting

DAY FIVE

- Work on painting
  - Talk through issues when they arise
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## DAY SIX

- Work on painting
- Talk through issues when they arise

## DAY SEVEN

- Work on painting
- Talk through issues when they arise
- Complete painting

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**Bring a Coffee mug** – regular black tea and coffee, full cream milk and sugar **are** supplied by the School. *\*should you require decaf, herbal teas, other milk types or artificial sweeteners please feel welcome to bring your own.*

**IMPORTANT: All electrical equipment required for your class at USQ must be 'tag-tested' by a qualified electrician prior to arrival in order to comply with Queensland Workplace Health & Safety legislation. Items include: extension cords, all power tools etc.**

### **HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES AND MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEETS.**

If you bring any hazardous substance to the McGregor School, please ensure that you obtain a MSDS (Material Safety Data Sheet) from the supplier or obtain one from the manufacturer of this substance.

To do this, either ask the supplier from whom you purchase the hazardous substance or read the contact details on the hazardous substance and contact the manufacturer and ask for a MSDS. Once you have obtained the MSDS, bring it with you to the school, and hand in a copy to the McGregor School office, or the Tutor.

Hazardous substance can be: e.g. solvents, acids, some paint and glues, chemicals, fixatives, fluxes and solders.

If you are unsure, the Supplier and or manufacturer should be able to inform you if the substance is classed as hazardous.

### **STRICTLY NO FILMING OR PHOTOGRAPHY OF ARTWORKS AT WORKSHOP**

Workshop runs 9.00am to 4.30pm. You must provide your own lunch Monday to Friday. Please note allergies will be catered for as best we can but depending on the level of dietary/allergy needed to be catered for this may incur a surcharge.

### **WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY – IMPORTANT!!**

As the McGregor Schools are the responsibility of the University of Southern Queensland all provisions of the Workplace Health and Safety Act and Regulations must be followed.

The Compliance Code for the Management of Hazardous Substances requires that

- A Register of all Hazardous Substances to be brought onto the Campus or used at the Winter School is to be completed by each Tutor before the commencement of the School and supplied to the McGregor Schools Office.
- A copy of each MSDS must be provided in each room or area that the hazardous substance is to be used
- All students must be informed of the MSDS before the Hazardous substance is used and students must be instructed to read the MSDS

Please enclose Material Safety Data Sheets for any hazardous substances you will be supplying for the class - e.g. dyes, paints, chemicals, etc
