

# **AWARD CONDITIONS - 2024**

## **Ipswich Railway RSL Scholarship**

#### Value

The scholarship will have a maximum value of \$5000 to be paid in two instalments.

### Eligibility

Recipient must:

- be a domestic student currently residing in Australia
- be a resident of the City of Ipswich as defined by the local government area (postcodes 4300, 4301, 4303, 4304, 4305, 4306, 4307, 4340, 4346)
- be continuing their full-time studies at UniSQ in a bachelor's degree program offered by the School of Psychology and Wellbeing, School of Health and Medical Sciences, or School of Nursing and Midwifery in Study Period 1 2024 (e.g., Trimester 1 2024)
- have, as at the release of results for Semester 2 2023:
  - a minimum of 6 and maximum of 10 study units completed and credited towards their current program (be entering into the second year of their degree)
  - a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0.

#### Conditions

- The duration of the scholarship is for 1 year.
- The scholarship will be forfeited if the recipient:
  - fails to continue to meet the eligibility criteria for the duration of the scholarship
  - changes their program outside of the eligible programs
  - $\circ$   $\,$  does not enrol in a minimum of 6 study units across the 2024 academic year, as follows:
    - minimum 3 study units in Study Period 1 (e.g., Trimester 1); and
    - minimum 3 study units across the remaining study periods (e.g., Trimesters 2 and 3)
  - withdraws from study at UniSQ
  - fails to maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0.
- UniSQ reserves the right to alter the conditions of the scholarship.

#### Payment

- Payments are made approximately 4 weeks after the first census date in the study periods of the recipient's program.
- Payment will be credited to the recipient's bank account in two instalments, as follows:
  - Study Period 1 \$2500
  - Study Period 2 \$2500
- Payment of the subsequent instalment will be subject to satisfactory progress in the recipient's study program. In the event the recipient does not continue to meet the scholarship's eligibility criteria and conditions, they may be required to show cause why the scholarship should not be cancelled.
